




## 2018 Mid-Term Election Results



The 2018 Mid-term Elections, with a record turnout, are finally over and there are several changes at the state and federal level.

- ✓ In Minnesota, Democratic Congressman Tim Walz from District 1 won the open seat for governor, defeating second time challenger – Republican, Jeff Johnson.
- ✓ Democrats flipped control of the Minnesota **State House of Representatives** (75 D / 59 R) with at least one recount pending.
- ✓ Republicans maintain control of the Minnesota **State Senate** (34 R / 33 D) with former MN Representative Jeff Howe claiming victory in the SD13 special election.
- ✓ We also saw Democratic Congressman (CD5), Keith Ellison, defeated Republican challenger Doug Wardlow for Attorney General. All Constitutional Offices were held by Democrats.
- ✓ On the federal level, Democrats flipped control of the U.S. House of Representatives. At the time this was written, the current totals: 223 D / 197 R. We are waiting on the results of 15 races. Republicans maintain control of the U.S. Senate, picking up 2 seats with the current totals: 51 R / 46 D. We are currently waiting on the results of the 3 remaining races. Sen. Klobuchar was easily re-elected, and Sen. Tina Smith won the US Senate Special election over REALTOR®, Karin Housley.
